Description	To improve the training of preclinical students of the undergraduate degree in dentistry has been provided to the Dental Clinic (Fac. of Medicine), an "Advanced preclinical laboratories." To achieve this we have adequate physical space, formerly occupied by the specialties of Clinical Orthodontics. When equipment was purchased X-ray equipment, sterilizing equipment, stools to work, a dental chair and equipment to suction and understanding needed for proper operation.
Goals	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Improve the skills of students before practice on real patients, within the framework provided in the course. Creation of 18 jobs that simulate the head and mouth of a patient. - Creation of 16 jobs, with art simulators. - Installation of a dental team to achieve proper ergonomics when working on real patients.
