Description	Professor in Molecular Nutrition and Metabolism at the University of Cambridge, Antonio Vidal-Puig, was the major figure in the Biomedicine Excellence Symposium, which took place in the Aula Ramón y Cajal of the Faculty of Medicine and Dentistry at the University of Valencia. Valencian Vidal-Puig, who is also the director of the University of Cambridge research laboratories in Addenbrooke's Hospital, gave a lecture entitled "Redesigning the Future of Biomedical Research". Organized by VLC/Campus Valencia International Campus of Excellence (UV, UPV and CSIC) and the INCLIVA health research institute, in collaboration with the Chair for Scientific Dissemination UCC+i of the University of Valencia, the event concluded with a research workshop involving internationally experienced researchers and students in the field of health.
